From time to time your child may need first aid in school. We have nominated staff that are trained first aiders, with additional members of staff having completed paediatric first aid training. If the injury is of concern, you will be contacted. I give permission for my child to receive first aid in school.		
We have a school adrenaline auto-injector (e.g., EpiPen) and a school inhaler and, if directed to do so by the emergency services , may need to administer these medications to your child. I give permission for the schools' adrenaline auto-injector or inhaler to be administered to my child if the school first aider is directed to do so by the emergency services. <i>If your child requires their own adrenaline auto-injector or inhaler, these must be kept in school with the appropriate form completed – please contact the school office for further information.</i>		

Handling pets in school

School Fruit Scheme

This school participates, along with other schools in the Midlands, in the National School Fruit Scheme. This is an initiative backed by the government and the NHS, which aims to increase the amount of fresh fruit in the diets of young children. The scheme provides **1 piece of fresh fruit** per school day, free of charge, to every child of infant school age. The fruit is delivered to the school and the children are given the fruit to be eaten at morning **playtime** by their class teacher.

Free School Meal Eligibility Checking

The current government Universal Free School Meal scheme supplies a free lunch to all infant school children. However, if you are receiving certain benefits, your child may be eligible for free school meals even if this government scheme was not operational.

This is also known as Pupil Premium and results in a payment made to school which is then used to help support eligible children in school. This is a crucial stream of funding to all schools.
